Beginner's Classes

What Is Involved?

These classes are group based lessons designed to teach all of the skills needed to take part in club fencing activities. This process will usually last for several months.

All of our coaches are trained through the British Academy of Fencing and hold current DBS certificates.

What Will It Cost?

Each session costs £5 which is payable by bank transfer in advance or directly upon arrival. To start with, you do not need to buy any kit and can borrow all the equipment you need from the club.

Who Is It For?

The lessons are designed for secondary aged children and adults. Children in the final years of primary may also join in if they can manage the weight of a training weapon safely.

When and Where?

Classes are held at the YMCA sports hall in Southport on Thursday evenings between 6pm and 7pm.

What Do You Need?

All attendees need to be dressed in jeans or jogging bottoms, a T-shirt and indoor trainers. All other equipment will be provided.

Can I Join The Main Club?

The main sessions immediately follow the beginner's class at 7pm. You are welcome to join in with those as soon as you feel confident enough.

Once you no longer need the beginner's training, you can swap to attending at 7pm along with the other established fencers.
